

Springhill Goldens

Guardian Program Agreement

This is a good faith contract between Springhill Goldens (breeder) and the below mentioned parties (guardian) for the sake of placing this Golden Retriever into a safe and loving home during her breeding age. The above mentioned dog is the physical property of and resides with the below mentioned Guardian, but is owned by Springhill Goldens (Jeremy and Heather Hunt) until obligations are met. It is understood by both parties that this female will be available for two breedings and the female must produce two litters of pups for Springhill Goldens at their discretion of time and property. This dog shall be registered in the name of the new owner in their home town ASAP as their personal pet.

- It is agreed that this dog will be bred on her second heat (if at least 20 months old or thereafter).
- She will be bred again on her third, and after her second litter she will be spayed and AKC papers will be signed over to her new owner.
- The Breeder has sole rights to the breeding of this dog and it is the responsibility of the new owner to have dog available at the breeder's home for her hip, eye and cardiac certifications.
- When breeding time arrives she will need to be available for one week of breeding during time of estrus and come back one week before due date and stay until pups are weaned and thriving (seven to eight weeks) new owner will be given proper notification prior to dates.
- This is not a "guarantee" of said dog's ability to pass all of her breeding tests. Instead, this is a good faith "privilege" in a joint effort to give this pup a wonderful home and keep a use of responsible breeding rights.
- All estrus cycles are to be reported promptly to breeder. This is for each contracted litter and it is important to note that the female must be kept away from other males and in a safe area during time of estrus to prevent an accidental breeding. . If an accidental breeding should occur, the new owner is to report promptly to Springhill Goldens and any action taken is to be at the discretion of the breeder.

- Estrus is approximately three weeks and each estrus cycle can be every eight to thirteen months after the first heat cycle. The first heat usually occurs at eight to fifteen months
- All pups will remain the property of the breeder and will be whelped and raised on the breeder's property for the completion of two successful breedings. Springhill Goldens considers 4 or more puppies to be a litter.
- This dog resides with the new owner solely and is the responsibility of the new owner to abide by all laws his or her town sets forth for dogs.
- The new owner must be able to provide proper care for the dog at all times. All food and Vet bills will be the responsibility of the new owner and Springhill Goldens requires that the breeding female be fed a balanced diet and kept on a high grade dog food. At this time dogs are being fed Canidae Dry All Life Stages. Yearly Veterinary checkup, required with vaccinations to include lime, heart worm testing, and medications for the prevention of heart worm, lime, flea and tick.
- Pictures are needed of dog every 3 months for web posting or brought to Springhill Goldens for a photo session. The pictures sent in have to meet with the approval of the breeder.
- No hair clipping is to be done to said dog other than feet or anal areas by client or groomers.
- The new owner shall receive \$500 after the first litter is 8 weeks of age and \$500 after the second litter is eight weeks of age.
- All AKC Registration papers will be signed over to new owner after proof of spaying at the end this dogs breeding time.
- This is done in a gesture of gratitude by the breeder. This dog is not to be sold or given to any other party and shall reside as the pet and property of new owner.
- If the new owner is unable to keep this dog for whatever reason-this dog shall be returned safely to Springhill Goldens and in a prompt manner of time.

- If the care of the dog becomes under question to the breeder for any reason, this dog will be returned to the breeder in a timely manner and can be taken from the guardian home voiding contract and all obligation of Springhill Golden.
